



## Letters of Interest to Host 2019 NorAm Eastern Canadian Championships

The CCC Events Committee is requesting event bids to host the 2019 NorAm Eastern Canadian Championships.

**Event Description:**

This is a FIS / CCC sanctioned Tier 1 event in combination with Quebec and Ontario Cup competitions. It is anticipated that the USSA Super Tour will be integrated into the program.

The current NorAm Technical Package located at <http://www.cccski.com/Events/Technical-Packages.aspx> should be used as reference. Please note that this document will be updated prior to the 2019 Competition Season to reflect best practices from the 2018 season.

**Competition Dates:**

end of January/early February

**Competition Formats: (race techniques to be confirmed)**

The event will consist of 3 competition days and will include:

- Sprint / Prologue competition, combined qualification, Sr & Jr Heats
- Interval start– 10/15 km Open Category; Junior categories as per Ontario/Quebec Cup guidelines
- Pursuit Start 10/15 km Open Category; Junior categories as per Ontario/Quebec Cup guidelines

Race categories will include Midget, Juvenile, Jr B/G, Jr M/W and Senior. In some instances, categories may be combined. Aggregate points will be accumulated in each category in support of the Division Aggregate title.

Clubs interested in hosting the 2019 Eastern Canadian Championships should send a Letter indicating your interest in hosting the event. Letters should confirm that the club executive is familiar with the NorAm Technical package and agree to follow the guidelines associated with the NorAm program. Please send your proposal to: Dave Dyer, CCC Events Director at [ddyer@cccski.com](mailto:ddyer@cccski.com) by March 23, 2018. Packages should include:

- Profile information of proposed sprint course
- Homologation details of distance course
- Available accommodation within a 20 km radius of the site

As per the guidelines outlined by the CCC Events Committee for Tier 1 events, hosting clubs must have Homologated Trails for the Open Category. The host community should be easily accessible to the majority of skiers in Eastern Canada and NENSA member clubs. Thank you for your interest.
